SUBJECT: Fuel Cell Filling Instructions

MODELS AFFECTED: PA-24 and PA-24 "250"
Serial Numbers 24-1 to 24-1264 inclusive

The above mentioned airplanes shall have a Fuel Cell Filling Instructions placard added to the left and right fuel cell filler neck cover plate during the next 100 hour periodic inspection. These instructions indicate the proper method of obtaining the maximum fuel tank capacity of thirty (30) gallons per tank.

Apply this placard per sketches shown on the reverse side of this bulletin by bending a corner of the placard sharply and peeling the film from the backing. Ascertain that the metal surface is clean and dry before placing the placard in the desired position and smoothing out with a squeegee.

Placards, part number 21994-00, will be furnished free of charge through your nearest Piper distributor or dealer. The airplane serial number must be included on all purchase orders.

No warranty labor will be allowed.

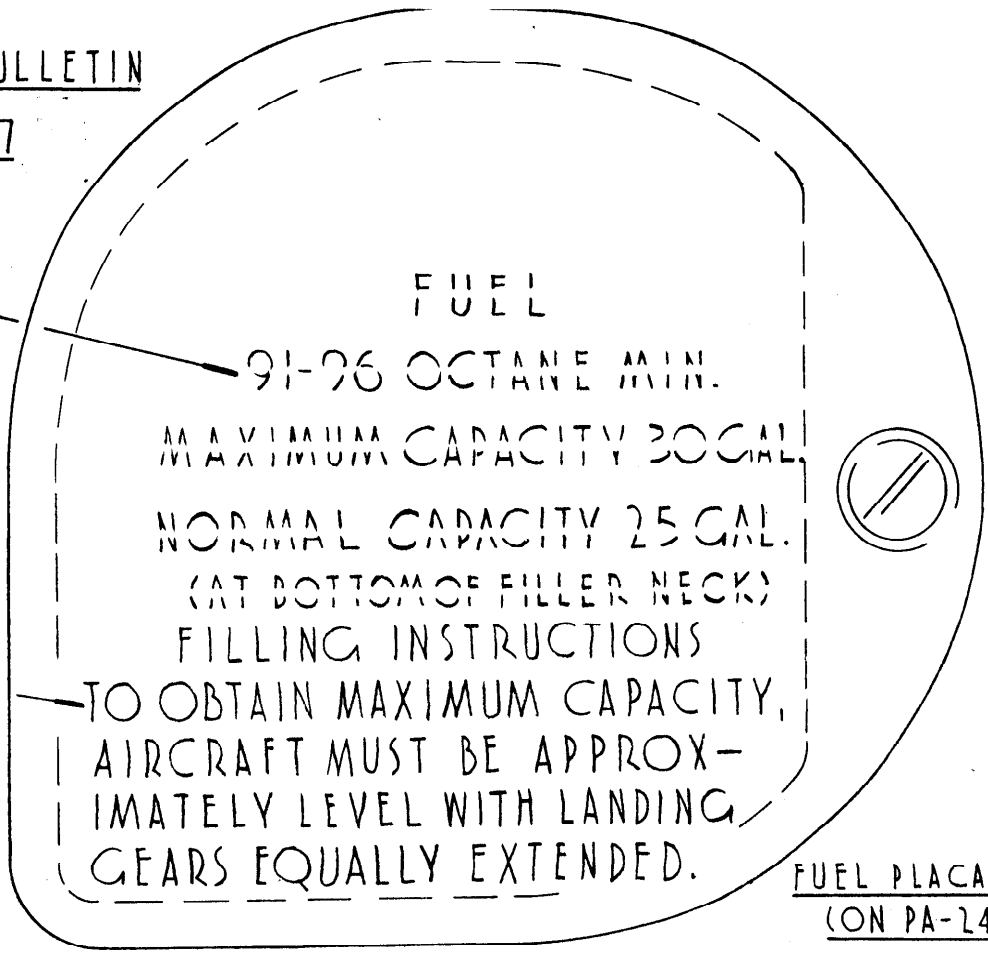

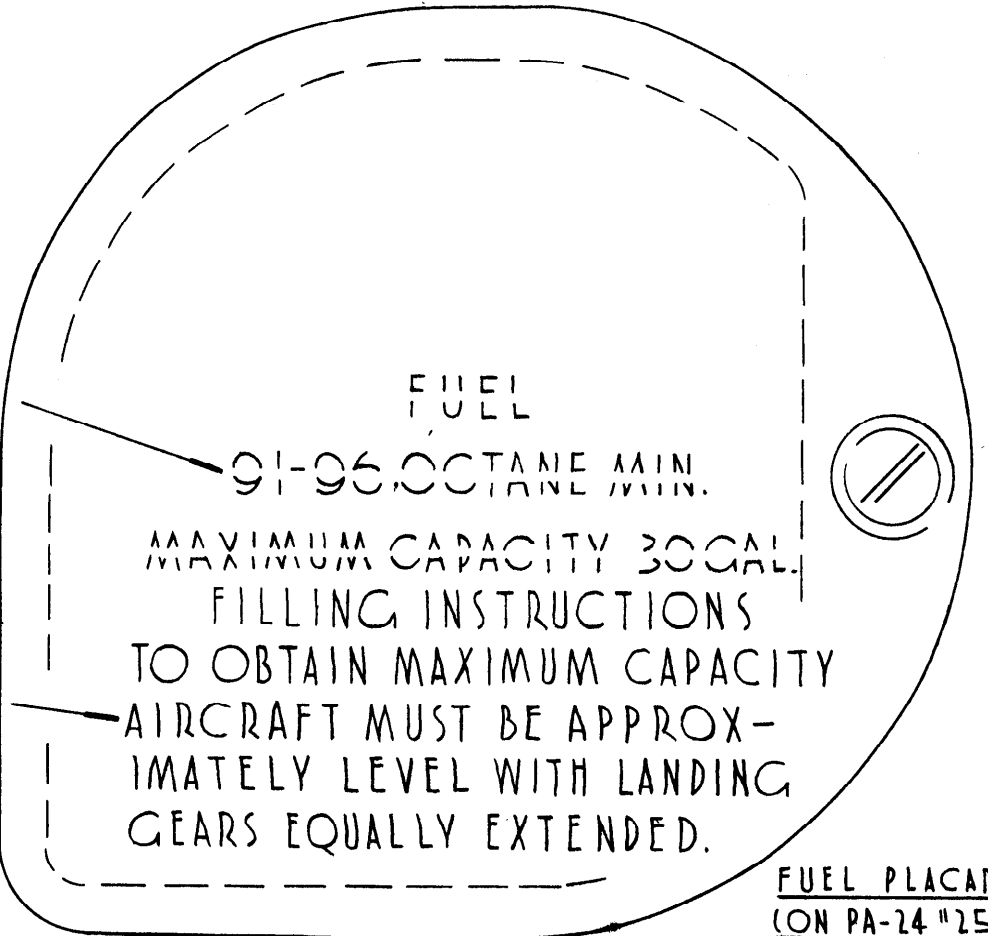
