COMPLIANCE TIME: Within the next twenty-five (25) hours of operation.

APPROVAL: The technical content of this Service Document has been shown to comply with

the applicable Federal Aviation Regulations and is FAA approved.

PURPOSE: It has been reported that improper procedures have been used in applying the

parking brake. If the parking brake handle is pulled and held prior to or at the same time as the application of the airplane brakes, little or no braking or reduced brake effectiveness will occur, resulting in inadvertent movement of the aircraft.

This Service Bulletin provides instructions for the installation of a "warning" placard on the Pilot's instrument panel. The placard warns against using improper procedures in applying the Parking Brake.

INSTRUCTIONS:

NOTE: Compliance with Service Bulletin No. 771A may be accomplished by owner/operator.

- 1. Install in a central location on the Pilot's instrument panel in full view of the pilot a Parking Brake Application Warning Placard Piper P/N 81090-002.
- Make appropriate logbook entry indicating compliance with this Service Bulletin.

MATERIAL REQUIRED: Placard, Piper P/N 81090-002, one (1) each per aircraft.

NOTE: Placard P/N 81090-002 may be identified as any one of these P/N's:

81090-2, 81090-02, or 683-107. All of these Piper P/N's describe the identical placard, and the installation of any one of these part numbers

provides compliance with this Service Bulletin

AVAILABILITY OF PARTS: Your Piper Service Facility.

EFFECTIVITY DATE: This Service Bulletin is effective upon receipt.
