Inspection of Landing Gear Transmission Retract Spring

MODELS AFFECTED:

All PA-24 Comanche Series and PA-30 Twin Comanche Series

Aircraft

The subject spring is located in the landing gear transmission well and raises the landing gear transmission jack screw to prevent the jack screw from dropping down and interfering with the landing gear mechanism during manual extension of the gear. See sketch on the reverse side of this Service Letter.

It is requested that this spring be inspected during routine inspections and, if broken, missing, or not functioning properly, a new spring must be installed.


