

TIME OF COMPLIANCE: OPERATORS DISCRETION

THERE HAVE BEEN ISOLATED REPORTS OF THE TURBOCHARGER INDUCTION DUCT RETAINING STUDS BACKING OUT AND BEING INGESTED INTO THE COM-PRESSOR SECTION OF THE TURBOCHARGER. TO PRECLUDE THIS FROM OCCURRING ON ANY FUTURE INSTALLATIONS, A REVISED ASSEMBLY WILL BE USED AS SHOWN BELOW:
