A field report has been received describing damaged electrical wiring in the battery area -- in the form of scorched or burned wires. This condition was attributed to improper attachment security of the battery ground strap and bonding wire (if installed) to the battery box mounting bolt.

This service release provides instructions to inspect wires as shown in the sketch (on reverse side of this Letter) for indications of scorching or burning and to relocate the battery ground strap and bond wire (if installed) to a new location on the inboard battery box support bracket (refer to the sketch/instructions on the reverse side of this Letter).
